INFORMATION ABOUT HIAWATHA KIDS LEAGUE (HKL)

***Funds must accompany shirt orders**

1. Last year we had 360 kids on team rosters. 230 boys played baseball and 130 girls played softball on a total of 31 teams.
2. Currently we play games Monday thru Thursday with an occasional Friday. Games are played at Guthridge Park in Hiawatha, Hiawatha Elementary School, Nixon Elementary School, on the diamond at Community of Christ Church in Hiawatha, and at Cherry Hill Park in Cedar Hills.
3. The fee for playing includes costs for a hat, shirt, and a team and individual picture. This is the only fee we collect but we do need you to volunteer one or more times per family per season.
4. Last year the cost per child, including equipment, care of the diamonds, umpires, insurance, office expenses, utilities, tournaments, hats, shirts, and pictures was about \$90.00.
5. Coaches meeting will be April 6th and practices start April 15th and continue until games start on May 28th. The season ends in July. **There will be an early season tournament May 31 & June 1, 2019 and a late season tournament July 12 & 13, 2019 with rain dates Monday – Saturday, July 15 thru 20, 2019.**
6. **Depending on the number of kids registering**, the following divisions are planned: Girls T-Ball – Alt Kindergarten, Kindergarten & 1st grade; Girls Machine Pitch, with the pitching machine used to pitch to the batters - 2nd & 3rd grade; Girls Majors - 4th, 5th, & 6th grade(with no Girls Seniors) or 4th & 5th grade(with Girls Seniors); Girls Seniors - 6th, 7th & 8th grade(if enough girls sign up); Boys Coach Pitch – Alt Kindergarten, Kindergarten & 1st grade; Boys Machine Pitch, with the pitching machine used to pitch to the batters - 2nd & 3rd grade; Boys Majors - 4th, 5th, & 6th grade; Boys Seniors - 7th, 8th, & 9th grade.

All decisions on divisions will be finalized after sign-ups are complete.

Placing children in divisions will be done by grade with no exceptions.

TEAM SELECTION WILL NOT BE BASED ON CAR POOLING!

Sign Up a Friend – If a player that played during the 2018 season gets a friend that didn't play in the 2018 season to sign up for the 2019 season, the friends will be allowed to play on the same team. (Limited to 1 friend per 2018 League member)

Volunteering Opportunities:

* Umpires - Umpires are paid by the league and training by HKL is required. You must be 14 years old by January 1, 2019 to be eligible. Adults are needed and encouraged to sign up to umpire. Visit our web site @ www.hiawathakidsleague.com for more information on being an umpire.
